Cindy will place a second order with the printer for another batch of tapes for distribution to members at meetings.

Post meeting note: After the 2018 sale, for which we received \$3,500, we looked into several options of spending the proceeds in a way that benefited all members. We were unable to identify a solution at the time and tabled the discussion. Since then, we have utilized some of the funds to benefit the Guild as follows:

- \$500 for the indigo dye workshop in 2020
- \$400 for the mandala workshop in 2021
- \$300 for the second tape measure order
